



## **Membership Terms for the Swedish Defence University Student Union**

### **1. General Terms**

By becoming a member of the Swedish Defence University Student Union (Försvarshögskolans Studentkår) (organization number 802002-3092), you agree to these terms, which may be updated. For questions regarding membership or issues, please contact: [medlem.karen@fhs.se](mailto:medlem.karen@fhs.se).

### **2. Membership**

The Swedish Defence University Student Union offers two types of membership: Ordinary Membership and Supporting Membership. Membership is governed in detail by the union's statutes, which apply to all members.

Ordinary Membership is Reserved for students at the Swedish Defence University who have paid the membership fee as determined by the union's general meeting. Membership is invalid if the member is not a student at the Swedish Defence University. A student is defined as someone who can present a valid registration certificate or equivalent proof of eligibility at the university.

Supporting Membership is open to individuals who are not students at the Swedish Defence University but wish to support the union's activities by paying the supporting membership fee determined by the general meeting. Supporting members do not receive any membership benefits available to ordinary members.

Membership in the Swedish Defence University Student Union is personal.

### **3. Benefits**

Ordinary members are entitled to benefits included with membership, provided they meet the criteria set by external partners.

Students in contract education programs are generally not eligible for the same external benefits, such as Mecenat cards. Members are responsible for ensuring they meet the criteria required by external partners.

Members must ensure their details are correctly registered with external partners, including activating their Mecenat card and ensuring their housing queue at SSSB remains active. Members without access to benefits despite active membership should contact [medlem.karen@fhs.se](mailto:medlem.karen@fhs.se) to resolve the issue.

### **4. Validity**

Membership is valid from the time the membership fee is received by the union until the end of the longest valid membership period. The membership periods are January through September (membership in the spring semester), and July through February (membership in the fall semester).

### **5. Termination of Membership**

Membership terminates when the member's studies at the Swedish Defence University are terminated, when the member has been duly dismissed from his/her studies at the Swedish



Defence University, when the member has not paid the membership fee for the specified period or when the member renounces his/her membership in writing.

Membership may be terminated for a member who violates rules, guidelines, policy charter or other rules established by the Swedish Defence University's student union. Cancelled membership is not refundable.

## **6. Personal Data**

By becoming a member of the Swedish Defence University Student Union, you consent to the processing of your personal data in accordance with the union's [privacy policy](#).

The union collects personal data such as name, date of birth, address, email, and gender for membership registration.

By registering as a member, you agree that your data may be shared with the Swedish Defence University, relevant partners, and authorities.

These details are shared with, for example, Mecenat AB and SSSB to provide relevant membership benefits. The union reserves the right to use members' data for statutory purposes, service provision, administration, invoicing, customer service, analysis, development, communication, marketing, and compliance with legal, contractual, or regulatory obligations.

## **7. Member Obligations**

Members must adhere to the union's established rules, policies, and regulations. Any member who violates the statutes or otherwise harms the union's operations, reputation, or members may be excluded by the board.

Members are responsible for ensuring their information is up-to-date and that they have access to their benefits.

## **8. Payment Terms**

When completing an order, the customer confirms they have read and accepted the terms and conditions. This is verified by completing the purchase. A purchase is considered complete when the customer has finalized the process and received a confirmation email.

If you do not receive the confirmation email or are unsure if the purchase went through, please contact [karen@fhs.se](mailto:karen@fhs.se). Customers must provide accurate and current details, including delivery address, email, and phone number.

The union reserves the right to cancel orders made by customers who fail to provide complete or correct information. This includes but is not limited to name, address, phone number, or payment details. Orders using discount codes meant for specific uses or placed by individuals not meeting the purchase requirements may also be canceled. Eligibility for discounts must be verifiable.



The parties to this agreement are the customer placing the order and the Swedish Defence University Student Union (organization number 802002-3092). Customers must be at least 18 years old to enter into an agreement with the union.

Membership fees are generally non-refundable.
